Scope and Contents

The bulk of the collection consists of documents, photographs, publications and ephemera of the Augsburg DP Camp in Germany in 1945-1949. In addition there are also some related materials of 1950s and one document of 1987. The collection is comprised of materials from various sources.

Historical note:

Augsburg, city of Bavaria, was in 1945-1949 a center of Ukrainian political and cultural life in Germany. There were two Ukrainian camps: "Somme-Kaserne" (approximately 4,000 persons) in 1945-1949, and in Haunstetten (approximately 500-2,000 persons) in 1945-1947. The Ukrainian National Council (UNRada) was active here (1945-1947), as well as other organizations and institutions.
